Take a SUV tour of the remote Taipivai Valley on Nuku Hiva and explore Herman Melville's former refuge and setting for his novel, Typee. Go with the flow as you learn drift snorkeling with Tiputa Pass experts, or float aimlessly above coral formations and colorful fish in Rangiroa's coral garden. Create the perfect romantic moment during an overnight port stay in Bora Bora at an iconic South Pacific beachside resort.

Matavai Bay boasts the only lighthouse of the island, built in 1867. A Handicraft Center is located next to the lighthouse and you will have a brief opportunity for some local shopping. Your last stop will be at the Tahara'a View Point for an extraordinary photo opportunity overlooking Papeete and Moorea. Please note : Guests are recommended to wear comfortable attire including non-slippery shoes, bring a hat, sunglasses, insect repellent and a water bottle from the ship. Bring a credit card or cash if you wish to purchase souvenirs. All sensitive belongings should be carried with caution. Expensive jewelry or clothing are not recommended on this tour. # Fakarava: Beach Escape



Enjoy round-trip transportation from your cruise ship to this privately owned beach, the ideal place to spend a few hours beachcombing in Fakarava. The atoll is being classified by UNESCO as a Biosphere Reserve and the beach will give you a nice and easy access to its crystal-clear waters. Put your fins on and jump in for a good refreshing swim or just sunbathe relaxing with a fresh coconut. Please note: This tour is NOT a transfer to a "resort" but to a local home. Facilities are simple and limited and this location boasts a very limited amount of coral formation, so water entry is an easy walk in. While coral snorkeling may be limited, bring your ship beach towels, ship mask and snorkel if you want to swim a bit further in the lagoon. Swimming is not supervised, so by participating in water activities, you must know how to swim, be comfortable in the water and able to cope with occasional currents. Depth of water is not guaranteed, due to currents and sea level variation, Guests are encouraged to wear reef shoes, cautioned not to touch or step on any coral formation, or touch any underwater animals for safety and environmental reasons. Shade is limited, so please use plenty of eco-friendly sun protection, and carry bottled water from the ship.

# Fakarava: Strolling in Fakarava by Ebike



Get on your E-bike to discover the North Fakarava atoll, from the village of Rotoava to the old lighthouse of Topaka. (also known as the pyramid of Fakarava) On your way back, your guide will take you on the oceanside trail to see how locals live in these latitudes and learn about their everyday routine. Before getting back to the pier, you will stop at the Church of Jean de la Croix built in the typical architecture of the Tuamotu Islands for a last picture opportunity. Please note: Tours DO operate in wet weather but all tours are subject to cancellation prior to departure dependent upon inappropriate weather conditions that would lead to safety issues. While this tour is an assisted bike ride, participants must be in good fitness condition to be able to keep up with a group at a fair speed during the tour. There will be riding on mostly flat uneven terrain, in a tropical environment (heat & humidity). Guests MUST know how to ride a bike and be comfortable with unpaved roads, Pregnant women and guests with physical limitations will not be permitted to participate on this tour. Guests are recommended to wear comfortable attire including non-slippery closed toe shoes and bring a hat, sunglasses, insect repellent and a water bottle from the ship. Long pants and a change of socks are highly recommended. The ride is approximately 13 km (8 miles) in length.

# Fakarava: Snorkeling at Pufuna



Board your boat for a 15-minutes ride (each way) close to the north pass in the lagoon for your snorkeling adventure. Your guide will give you safety instructions and information about the site before entering the water from the boat. You will then start your snorkeling experience around the coral head. You will discover a wide variety of species: fish common to the area include sharks, tropical fish like groupers, parrot fish, and triggerfish. Please note: This deep water activity is only recommended for experienced swimmers in good physical condition who are comfortable wearing snorkeling equipment. Life vests will be available on the boat if needed. Although marine life is widely present in this region, sightings cannot be guaranteed and tickets are non-refundable should sightings not occur. For your own safety and to help us preserve the environment, do not touch or step on the coral reef while snorkeling.

# Fakarava: Two Tank Dive



This program is for Certified Divers looking to do a half day of diving (approximately 4 hours). The typical time underwater for the 2 tank dive is 45 minutes for the first dive, with a 1 hour of surface interval followed by a second dive of approximately 45 minutes. Fakarava is under UNESCO protection, so the coral is pristine and there is a huge underwater biodiversity and the density of the school of fish are unbelievable. You can see plenty of sharks, manta rays, napoleons, etc. The dives are taking place on the north pass of Fakarava, the largest one in French Polynesia, also known for the density of its marine life and wall of sharks. Expect some strong currents, incoming or outgoing, depending on the tides and weather conditions. This dive is known as the most beautiful one in French Polynesia. Please note: The Dive Tour being offered is for Certified Divers only. Certified Divers need to bring their PADI - CMAS Cards or other proof of certification, including a log book. Waiver release forms must be signed and medical conditions must be disclosed. Bring your C-card. Itrox is free of charge for Nitrox Certified Divers. Please wear your swimsuit under your clothing and bring a towel, spare t-shirt and sun block. Divers 75 years of age or older must present a medical certificate and diving insurance.

## Fakarava: Blue Lagoon



Embark on a unique journey to discover Fakarava's lagoon, classified by UNESCO as a biosphere reserve. Between sightseeing for sea birds in their natural environment, enjoying the different shades of green and blue from the lagoon, and swimming in the pristine waters, you will feel what it's like to be a castaway in paradise. Snorkeling will operate directly from the boat, participants should note that they will enter some areas where water is too deep to stand in and harmless black tipped sharks may be present. Fakarava has a wide and deep lagoon with a surface of 429 square miles (1,112 sq. km) and two passes. The main pass to enter the lagoon, located in the northwestern end, is known as Passe Garuae and is the largest pass in French Polynesia. The current in these passes is usually fairly strong because of the enormous amount of water that exits/enters the lagoon between the low and the high tides. This may affect the conditions inside the lagoon so timing on this tour is very dependent from this natural fact. Snorkeling time and location may be adjusted as needed to ensure a safe and enjoyable excursion. Please note: No restroom facilities are available on this tour. At operator's discretion, a waiver may be required to be filled out prior to departure. The operator will require guests participating in water activities, to know how to swim, be comfortable in the water and able to cope with occasional currents. Depth of the water is not guaranteed, due to currents and sea level variation, guests are reminded to verify their ability prior to take part in a water activity. Wildlife sightings are likely but never guaranteed. Sailing onboard a boat requires vigilance; guests must be physically alert of the boat environment and fit to negotiate steps and vessel surroundings. While snorkeling equipment is available (mask & snorkel) we recommend you bring your own for maximum comfort. Bring water shoes or wear shoes that you do not mind getting wet. Wear your

swimsuit under a cover-up and bring a hat, towel, and bottled water from the ship. Biodegradable sun protection is recommended since most sunscreens contain substances that are extremely harmful to the marine ecosystem. For your own safety and to preserve the environment, please respect reef etiquette when snorkeling and do not touch or step on the coral reef.

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The final home and resting place of painter Paul Gauguin and singer Jacques Brel, Hiva Oa is watched over by many large stone tiki statues and boasts the tallest peak in the Marquesas, Mount Temetiu at 3,980 feet. Relax on black-sand beaches or try the diving or snorkeling, said to be among the best or find the Tehueto Petroglyphs. Please note: This destination is an open anchorage, and calls are subject to change or cancellation based on weather and sea conditions.

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The second largest island in French Polynesia, this remote island is full of natural beauty in its deep bays, lush valleys, rocky peaks and narrow cliffside roads where you might come upon wild ponies. Giant banyan trees are found around ancient marae temples and ceremonial stone platforms as well as tiki statues outside huts. Find the 40-foot-tall Tiki Tuhiva sitting atop Mount Muake. Another interest is Tohua Koueva Archaeological Site with detailed restoration of ancient Marquesan life.

# Taiohae, Tapivai Valley, Scenic Drive

Taipivai Valley was originally made famous by the American writer and former sailor, Herman Melville (1819-1891), who deserted his ship and hid in this valley. Captured by the indigenous natives, he lived there three weeks, a period during which he observed their way of life. This experience enabled him to write the novel 'Typee'. This landmark was more recently made famous by being the base camp for the "Survivor" TV Show screened here in 2001. Your road drive will lead you through valleys among lush vegetation and great viewpoints. The coastline of this part of the island is breath-taking and insures you a rewarding time for pictures. You will pass small villages, churches, sacred temples and ""Te A'itua"" site to enjoy refreshments reach Hooumi black sand beach before returning back to the pier. Handicraft is usually available at ""Te A'itua"" site, please make sure to have small denominations, credit cards not accepted.

Please note:

Travelling to the Marquesas is discovering secluded islands, with limited facilities. Excursions run with local's vehicles SUV double cabin style, seating 4 pax (1 front+ 3 back). All vehicles cannot be guaranteed AC. Drivers speak limited English, sometimes no English at all. This tour is mainly a sightseeing tour. Most of the drive is done over a hard flat road, the short drive to reach the beach may be a little bumpy.

Your journey includes about 45 minutes by taxi and boat to reach the Green Lagoon. You will be welcomed on the beach to the sound of local music. Once you're there it is your choice to grab a coconut drink, walk the beach and take a dip in the interior lagoon. Enjoy a relaxing time while watching at coprah and weaving demonstrations. Before returning back to your ship, you will be given a traditional shell lei as a memory.

Swimming is not supervised, it is required that if you will be participating in water activities, you know how to swim, be comfortable in the water and able to cope with occasional currents. Depth of the water is not guaranteed, due to currents and sea level variations. You will be cautioned not to touch or step on any coral formation, or touch any underwater animals for safety and environmental reasons. Shade is limited, so please insure to use plenty of eco-friendly sun protection, towel and carry bottled water from the ship! Please note: French Polynesia geological features include coral reef, coral beaches, sea, mountain and some uneven grounds. Guests are recommended to wear comfortable appropriate attire including shoes (walking, water or hiking as needed) biodegradable sun protection (cream, hat, rashguard), insect repellent, sunglasses, and bottle of water. Expensive jewelry or clothing should not be worn on tour. The environment is constructed of living creatures. Coral is fragile and can be hurt. # Rangiroa: Glass Bottom Boat



Here is a wonderful and easy way to get acquainted with the coral gardens and tropical fish of Rangiroa. You will board a glass bottom boat and float slowly over the massive coral heads that cluster in the shallow areas next to the Tiputa Channel. You will look through the large windows that open onto a colorful world full of parrot, butterfly and surgeonfish. It is likely that you will also encounter black tipped sharks and the majestic napoleon fish. A cover provides protection from the sun and eliminates glare, so you are sure to take home some great photos. The boat crew will attract the fish to come right under the glass panels to allow you easy viewing and photos. Please note : The Tuamotus are very remote islands. This is mainly a scenic tour, so commentary from the crew will be very limited /almost non-existent. Their command of English may be very poor. Your patience and understanding are greatly appreciated. Wear comfortable attire including shoes, insect repellent, sunscreen and a bottle of water. Expensive jewelry and expensive clothing should not be worn.

Harmless black tipped sharks may be present. ## Rangiroa: Visit Gauguins Farm



Transfer by bus along the main road of Rangiroa, passing the airport just before turning into the Black Pearl Farm . Most pearl farms are small in size, and the number of staff here is quite typical of the farms in this region. On arrival at the farm, the staff will provide an introduction to pearl farming and explain how black pearls are produced. Learn about the chronology and evolution of the industry, how oysters are selected, grown and then grafted for production. Grafting is the key element , as this requires a skilled craftsman to perform precise surgery on each oyster. The real highlight of the excursion is the opportunity to view a selection of unset black pearls that are also available for purchase. Here your guide will be able to show you the criteria by which the pearls are graded for quality. You will see the round, baroque and semi-baroque pearls that range in grade from C to A+. This tour is ideal for those who have an interest in learning about pearl cultivation or for those who are shopping for black pearls. Kindly note that the transfer will be operated by minibus/van, some jumps seats may be used. Transfers remain a short drive with no comments. Please note : The prices are fixed; cash, Visa or MasterCard are accepted. The Tuamotus are very remote islands. Although the guides used are the best available, they are not certified and their command of English may be very poor. Your patience and understanding is greatly appreciated.

Anau: A lagoon dive in which you will follow a slope where rose corals grow and you are very likely to meet manta rays there. Please note : Wear your swimsuit under your clothing and bring a towel. Waiver release form must be signed and medical conditions must be disclosed. SCUBA equipment is provided. Divers 75 years of age or older must present a medical certificate and diving insurance.

## Bora Bora: 2 Tank Certified Dive



This program is for Certified Divers looking to do a half day of diving (approximately 4 hours). The typical time underwater for the 2 tank dive is 45 minutes for the first dive, with a long surface interval followed by a second dive of approximately 45 minutes. For guests only wanting a one tank, you can go at the same price and may choose to snorkel or swim while the second dive is going. Dives will take place at two of the following three sites (weather dependent). Tapu: An ocean dive and one of the most famous dive sites of Bora Bora. From the coral drop-off, you will meet lemon sharks, black tip sharks, humphead maori wrasses, moray eels, turtles. Toopua: A lagoon dive where many tropical fish gather along the wall, among others, anemones and clown fish. At the bottom, you find a large sand bank where eagle rays and sting rays wander searching for food. You will anchor or drift dive depending upon weather conditions. Anau: A lagoon dive in which you will follow a slope where rose corals grow and you are very likely to meet manta rays there. The visibility here may not be as clear sometimes due to the plankton. Please note: The Dive Tour being offered is for Certified Divers only. Certified Divers need to bring their PADI - CMAS Cards or other proof of certification, including a log book. Waiver release forms must be signed and medical conditions must be disclosed. Bring your C-card. Nitrox is free of charge for Nitrox Certified Divers. Please wear your swimsuit under your clothing and bring a towel, spare t-shirt and sun block. Please take a refresher course before the cruise if you haven't been diving in over a year. Divers 75 years of age or older must present a medical certificate and diving insurance.

Great views of Bora Bora's natural harbor and Matira Beach await! Continue with more off-road adventure and visit the 7-inch cannons still in their original World War II locations. Travel along the northern shore of Bora Bora into the lush valley of Faanui. Perhaps the highlight of the trip is the view of Faanui Bay from a traditional plantation high up in the mountains .On your return to the main road, pass by Matira Beach. With your guide at the wheel, you'll enjoy some great sightseeing, learn much about the island's history and people and see how to wear a pareo (wrap-around skirt). Please note: This excursion involves rough off-road driving and steep ascents and descents. It is therefore not recommended for overweight guests, those with bad backs, pregnant women or persons who suffer from motion sickness or vertigo. The vehicles accommodate 8 guests each. Large families or couples may be split up depending on tour numbers. On weekends and holidays, the pareo demonstration may be done at a different location.

You will then return to the Waverunner center, and back to the pier. Please note: The total Waverunner ride is approximately 90 minutes and goes around the whole island. The cost of this tour is per Waverunner which can accommodate two average-sized adults (max 440 lbs. / machine). Tour is sold PER machine, not PER person, so when booking; please select only one ticket (for 1 or 2 passengers). For insurance purposes, each driving participant must be at least 16 years of age. The minimum age to ride as a passenger on this tour is 10 years old.
