Wide avenues, exotic landscapes, and striking examples of modernist architecture complete one of the world's most popular destinations.

A Tale of Two Cities with Transfer to airport TFN NORTH

Discover the rich history, culture, and flavours of Tenerife on this captivating tour through two of the island's most fascinating destinations. Your journey begins with a narrated panoramic drive through Santa Cruz de Tenerife, the vibrant capital and one of Spain's busiest and most important ports, before a visit to the remarkable Man and Nature Museum, housed in the historic Old Civil Hospital. Spread across three floors, the museum's compelling exhibits trace the volcanic origins, extraordinary wildlife, and human history of the Canarian Archipelago, including a rare opportunity to view the mummified remains of the island's original inhabitants. From Santa Cruz, the coach continues to the enchanting city of La Laguna, a UNESCO World Heritage destination and once the island's capital, where a guided walking tour through the beautifully preserved old quarter reveals centuries of history dating from the 17th and 18th centuries, taking in the elegant Plaza del Adelantado, the Leal Theatre, the Plaza de la Concepción, the Plaza del Cristo, and the grand Palacio del Obispo. The tour concludes with a refined wine and cheese tasting at the elegant Restaurante Casino de La Laguna, where three local wines paired with regional cheese make for a delightful farewell to Tenerife, before the coach transfers you directly to Tenerife North Airport (TFN).

What to Bring: Seasonal clothing, closed shoes, water, and local currency. Please note: wine tasting is available to guests aged 18 and over in accordance with Spanish law. Photography inside the museum is not permitted. Itinerary and order of sights may vary depending on weather conditions.

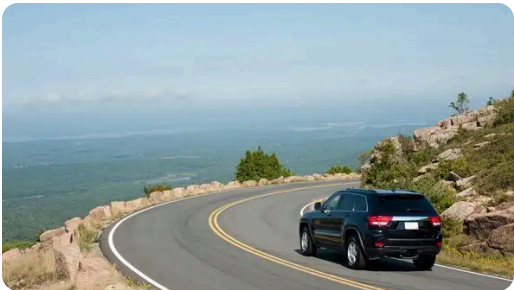

La Gomera - Short Island Tour *

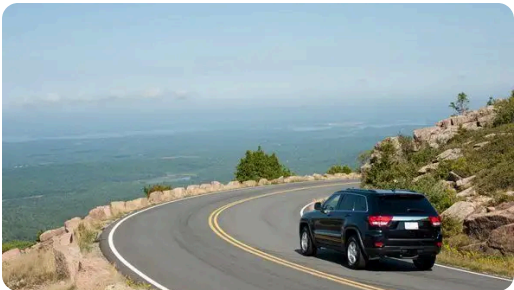


From San Sebastian, the island's capital, you'll visit La Gomera's most interesting sights, traveling by motor coach. First you'll head north to the agricultural valley of Hermigua , famous for its banana plantations. The Garajonay National Park covers the southern part of this municipality and one of its landmarks is the twin rocks " Roques de San Pedro ." You will see the subtropical thermophile forest of Laurisilva Woods before traveling on to the small, enchanting village of Agulo . Surrounded by a massive basalt wall almost 984 feet high, Agulo offers a breathtaking view of the nearby island of Tenerife. It's a short 15-minute drive to Centro Visitantes Juego de Bolas in Las Rosas a center where you will learn the history of how the island was formed. Your next destination will be Laguna Grande in the middle of the National Park Garajonay, where you will enjoy a guided walk. Head to Agando , where you will see the magnificent landscape of volcanic basalt formations at Roques de Agando and Orchilla , one of La Gomera's most striking features at 4,074 feet high. Then, your motor coach will return you to your yacht. Please note: This tour is not recommended for wheelchairs or people with mobility issues due to the amount of walking required. All roads on La Gomera are winding and there are some ravines. It is advised that you bring your camera, comfortable shoes and seasonal clothes like a jacket are recommended.

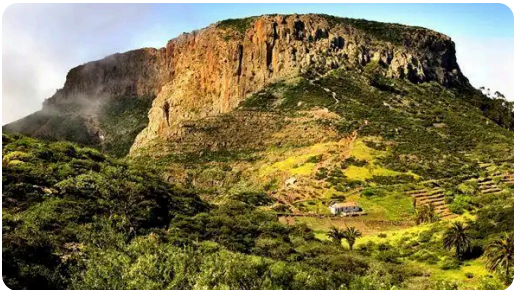

La Gomera - Gomera Delight *



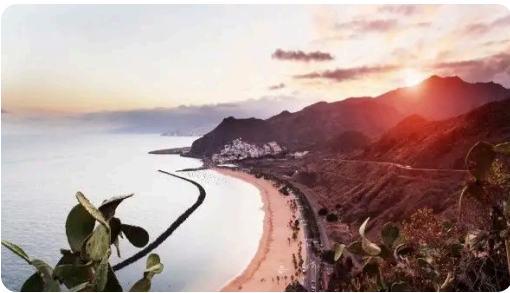
Board your motor coach to travel to the wonderful forest of Garajonay , recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and your first destination after leaving the island capital, San Sebastian. Standing at over 4,000 feet above sea level, the views you'll see provide a magnificent panorama that stretches to the neighboring islands of Tenerife in the east and La Palma in the west. Making a number of stops along the way, you will have a myriad of opportunities to take photographs and enjoy the view. You will then begin your descent to the coast. Included on this tour is a visit the incredible Valle Gran Rey , home of the island's last "Guanche" Chieftain, and you will learn about the conquest of La Gomera at the beginning of the 15th century. Dominated by the surrounding curtain of mountains, you'll discover remote communities and terraced farms that cling to the valley walls all around. A short stop for refreshments in Arure will be made then route back to your ship in San Sebastian. Please note : This tour is not wheelchair accessible. Guests are advised to wear seasonal clothing, a jacket, closed shoes, and bring water, local currency and camera.

La Palma, Hiking La Palmas Newest Volcano

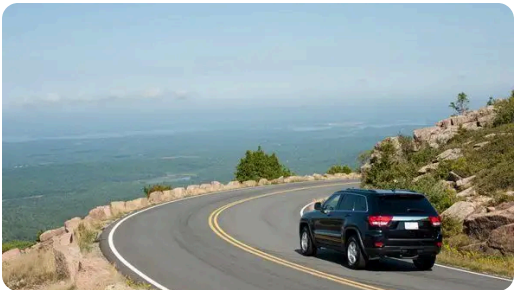
On September 19, 2021, La Palma experienced a defining moment when a new volcano erupted from Cumbre Vieja, reshaping the island’s young and volcanic landscape. This journey begins at the Caldera de Taburiente Visitor Center, where a detailed topographic model introduces the island’s geological evolution. From there, the path leads through Llano de El Jable, where layers of ash and lapilli reveal both the destructive force of the eruption and the resilience of the Canarian pine forest. At the Tajogaite crater, breathtaking views showcase the vast lava flows that transformed towns in the Aridane Valley. The experience concludes at the Mirador de Tajuya, a symbolic vantage point that once served as a communal lookout during the eruption, now offering a powerful perspective on nature’s ability to both devastate and renew.

Santa Cruz de Palma, Volcanoes & Wine *



Drive through vineyards and lava streams passing pine trees and small villages towards the deep south - the area where the volcanoes take charge. Arriving at Fuencaliente, a famous wine-producing region, you will visit the San Antonio volcano. Here you may be able to walk over the crater border and stroll around the Visitor Centre. A visit will be made to a typical bodega, where you will have the opportunity to sample some of the local red and white wines. You may also wish to purchase the wines that you have sampled. A short drive will bring you to the pottery center of 'El Molino' in Mazo. Located in an old windmill, this pottery is unique to the Benahorita people, which is to this day lovingly reproduced. There is a gift shop for you to purchase those all-important souvenirs. Please note : The walk near the volcanoes is over rough, graveled ground and narrow, uneven paths with some inclines. Please follow your guide's instructions and do not venture near the edge of the walking trail, as there are no handrails or barriers. There are some steep inclines and steps at El Molino Pottery. This tour is not recommended for guests suffering from vertigo. The walking at the Volcano is optional. Wear comfortable walking shoes and layered clothing.

Santa Cruz de Palma, Leisurely de La Palma *



This panoramic introduction to La Palma is ideal for those who prefer to tour at a more relaxed pace. Embark on a scenic panoramic drive to the west of the island and through the upper region of the Aridane Valley . The area is the highest point of the island and is also home to the charming town of El Paso . Enjoy a little free time to take some photos and admire the town's beautiful surroundings. You'll leave El Paso and take a short drive to the delightful La Glorieta Square. The square is the work of local artist, Luis Morera, who was once a pupil of César Manrique. Here, you can enjoy a photo stop and view the unique and colorful mosaic floor, reminiscent of Manrique's designs found in Lanzarote. Afterwards, you'll head to the southern tip of La Palma and on to Fuencaliente . There will be some time to relax during a refreshment stop at a local restaurant, before the return drive to the port. Please note : This tour involves limited walking, however passengers must be able to negotiate steps on to and off the coach. The drive involves some hairpin bends and is not suitable for those who suffer from vertigo. Wear comfortable walking shoes and layered clothing.

Funchal, Panoramic Drive & Tuk Tuk Stroll *



This tour is a new and exciting way to discover the charms and beauties of Funchal. By using two means of transportation, you will be able to admire fantastic views of Funchal by visiting the most important viewpoints of the city with a minivan. Leaving the pier by minivan or motor coach you will proceed towards Pico dos Barcelos , where you can see distant Funchal and the surrounding villages scattered over the green slopes. Continue towards Cabo Girão , the highest sea cliff in Europe and the second highest in the world. Soaring 1,900 feet, its etched face tells the tale of its volcanic origins. From this impressive promontory, you will have breathtaking views along the island's southern coast. Passing by Estreito de Camara de Lobos , known for its vineyards, you will reach Camara de Lobos , a well-known fishing village. There, you will see its lovely, quaint setting of red-tile-roofed houses clustered on the rocky point and the brightly painted fishing boats anchored in the harbor. The second part of this tour will be by Tuk Tuk , built upon ecological and innovative criteria, directly inspired by the Italian Dolce Vita glamorous style and the iconic 3-wheeled Ape Calessino. It offers those who visit Funchal an exclusive perspective along with an intimate approach to our history and culture. Please note : Wear comfortable walking shoes. Order of sights visited may vary. Tuk Tuk suspension is not recommended for people with any sort of back problems. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or in a wheelchair. Funchal, Quinta House with Tea and Gardens

Sit down to an exquisite tea service paired with scones and homemade jams, a slice of cake and sandwiches. Then, stroll the estate's lush gardens. Learn about the 500 species of plants and flowers cultivated at the Quinta Jardins do Lago. See rare species of old trees and delicate flowers while wandering through the aromatic blooms. After your walk through the gardens, board your bus for a short drive back to the pier. 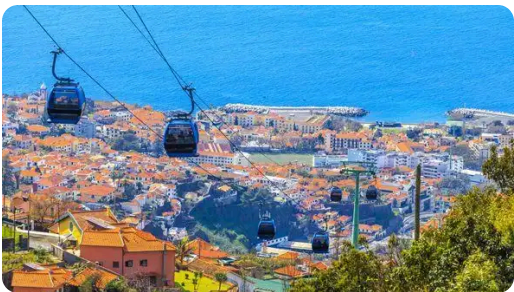

Funchal, City Highlights and Cable Car *



Explore the adventurous city of Funchal, capital of Madeira and Portugal's largest town. You will board your motor coach for the short 10-minute drive to the center of town. Walk through the vibrant local market, explore the Old Town where the first settlement of the city was born. This old part of the city is characterized by its narrow sidewalk streets and façades of old houses and is considered a historical area of great architectural and patrimonial value. You will climb to Monte by cable car. This village located at an elevation of 1,772 feet high was the last residence of Carlos I of Austria, who is buried in the Church of Our Lady of Monte. Finally you will have a 25-minute drive to visit the Old Blandy Wine Lodge in the center of Funchal which acts as an excellent show place for many the finest wines of Madeira. You will taste four 5-years-old wines accompanied by some delicious snacks. Please note: Wear comfortable walking shoes. Guests must be legal age to consume alcohol. The market and the Old Blandy Lodge are closed Saturday afternoons, Sundays and public holidays all day. A visit to the church of Monte is not included and is closed on Sundays and public holidays. Should guests wish to visit it, it is free of charge and they have to be able to climb 171 steps up and 68 steps down. Tour order may vary but all sites will be covered. Shops are closed during public holidays. This tour is not available for guests in wheelchairs and others with mobility challenges.

Majestic Eastern Madeira with Vineyard Lunch

Embark on a spectacular full-day journey through the very best of Madeira's landscapes, history, and flavours. Departing Funchal, travel through the city centre and past the picturesque village of Monte before ascending to Terreiro da Luta, where sweeping panoramic views over Funchal and the Atlantic set the tone for the day ahead. Continue into the heart of the island's UNESCO-listed Laurisilva Forest at Ribeiro Frio, where, weather permitting, a leisurely walk along the Balcões viewpoint trail reveals rare indigenous flora, birdlife, and the extraordinary ancient laurel woodland that has survived for millennia. Descending through Faial, you'll arrive in the enchanting village of Santana, celebrated for its iconic thatched-roof houses, before continuing to the Quinta do Furão vineyard for an elegant sit-down lunch: Santana bread with butter and seasoned olives, a seasonal vegetable cream soup, followed by a choice of scabbard fish fillet with sweet potato and passion fruit sauce or roasted pork loin with mashed potatoes and seasonal vegetables, rounded off with a passion fruit mousse — all paired with local red or white wine and coffee. The afternoon brings a coastal stop at Porto da Cruz, with its scenic bay and historic explorer's cross, before passing through the legendary Machico Valley — the landing site of Madeira's first settlers. The day concludes at Ponta do Garajau, where the striking Christ the Redeemer statue stands with outstretched arms over the Atlantic, offering breathtaking final views of Funchal and the Garajau Natural Park before returning to the ship.

Funchal, Forest 4X4 with Wine Tasting

Leave the pier behind and set out on an off-road journey through Madeira’s wild and dramatic landscapes. Begin with a scenic drive toward the lush Serra de Água valley, followed by a stop at the Encumeada Pass—an impressive viewpoint perched 1,000 meters above sea level. From here, enjoy panoramic views stretching from the island’s northern to southern coasts, framed by the green valleys of Ribeira Brava and São Vicente.

Continue your adventure through the island’s UNESCO-listed Laurisilva Forest, one of the world’s few remaining laurel forests and a sanctuary of rare plants and bird species. Experience the thrill of open-roof Land Rover travel as you navigate winding trails surrounded by dense vegetation and mountain peaks.

Your journey concludes with a visit to Quinta do Barbusano, a picturesque vineyard nestled among terraced hills. Savor a tasting of Madeira’s local red, white, and rosé wines paired with regional snacks, while taking in peaceful views of the surrounding countryside.

Relax on the scenic return drive to Funchal, carrying with you memories of Madeira’s natural beauty, cultural heritage, and adventurous spirit.

Funchal, Cabo Girao & Ribeira Brava *



Spend a relaxing day exploring the small towns and picturesque countryside of Madeira . Begin with a trip to the Pico da Torre viewpoint for an incredible view of Camara de Lobos, a quintessential fishing village characterized by brightly painted boats in the harbor. Taste the famous poncha , a delightful local drink made of rum and honey on your way to Cabo Girao , the highest sea cliff in Europe and the second highest in the world. It features a skywalk with an amazing glass floor balcony (1,932 feet up).
